SUMMARY: Reduces the graduate medical training required for international medical graduates from 3 years to 2 years to modernize the process utilized for licensure. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the act of December 20, 1985 (P.L. 457, No. 112), known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, to reduce the required years of graduate medical training (residency) for international medical graduates from 3 years to 2 years.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
