SUMMARY: Allows the Commonwealth to observe daylight saving time (DST) year-round if Congress authorizes states to do so. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Act No. 18 of 1887 to establish the standard of time in the Commonwealth to be DST when the Congress of the United States authorizes states the ability to do so. This standard of time will be year-round.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or political subdivision funds.
