**SUMMARY:** House Bill 425, printer's number 938, amends section 406 of the Liquor Code to allow for the sale of wine and liquor by a licensee that is permanently closing to another licensee. This act shall take effect immediately.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill allows a licensee that is permanently closing to sell their remaining stock of wine and liquor to another licensee qualified to sell such products. The licensee that is closing is required to notify the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (PLCB) in writing of the name of the licensee, and identifying any product sold to that licensee, as well as the description of the liquor, including brand names, sizes and numbers of containers sold.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
