SUMMARY: Amends the Workers' Compensation Act to provide employers or their insurance the right to treat a third-party settlement related to a workers' compensation claim as a credit for future medical costs. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 319 of the Workers' Compensation Act by removing the words "instalments of."

By removing these words, an employer would have the right to claim a credit against future medical benefits after a third-party settlement or recovery.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or political subdivision funds.
