SUMMARY:

House Bill 934 repeals Act 169 of 1978 known as the Pennsylvania Crime Commission Act. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 934 repeals the Pennsylvania Crime Commission Act which was established in 1978 and expired in 1993. Repealing this act eliminates a statute that has long been obsolete.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
