SUMMARY: Amends the Cosmetology Law to authorize licensed cosmetology schools to provide a portion of instruction through distance education. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Cosmetology Law of 1933 to provide licensed cosmetology schools the ability to offer up to 50% of the school's curriculum through distance education.

Under the legislation, licensed cosmetology schools are only permitted to offer distance education for hours in the curriculum that are theory-based content; practical "hands-on" hours in the curriculum will not have this flexibility and will still be required to be delivered through in-person instruction.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
