SUMMARY: Designates a portion of a road in Snyder County as the Chief of Police Tony M. Jordan Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of PA Route 104, from the southern border of the Borough of Middleburg to the northern border of the Borough of Middleburg in Snyder County as the Chief of Police Tony M. Jordan Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
