SUMMARY: Creates an exception that would allow municipal-owned vehicles to exceed maximum gross weight and maximum axle weight. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Title 75 (Vehicles) to permit a municipal-owned three-axle motor vehicle to exceed the 58,400-pound maximum gross weight limit if the gross weight is not more than the vehicle's gross vehicle weight rating or 66,000 pounds, whichever is less.

The legislation also provides that the maximum axle weight limits shall not apply to a municipal-owned three-axle vehicle if each axle does not exceed 24,000 pounds (or an overall gross weight of 66,000 pounds).

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
