**SUMMARY:** Adds the Pennsylvania Bulletin to the Uniform Electronic Legal Material Act and allows for its different publication as circumstances require. This legislation would take effect immediately.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Chapter 7 of Title 44 (Law and Justice) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes by adding the Pennsylvania Bulletin to the definition of "Legal Material" with the Pennsylvania Code. In addition, the definition of "Official Publisher" is changed to include the Pennsylvania Bulletin, along with the Pennsylvania Code, for whom the Joint Committee on Documents is the official publisher.

The legislation further amends Chapter 7 of Title 45 (Legal Notices) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes relating to the frequency and format of the Pennsylvania Bulletin adding that the Joint Committee on Documents can provide for different publication (instead of more frequent publication) as circumstances may require.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
