SUMMARY: Designates a portion of Pennsylvania Route 31 from Strikertown Road to Renaissance Lane in South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, as the John Michael Beyrand Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of Pennsylvania Route 31 from Strikertown Road to Renaissance Lane in South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, as the John Michael Beyrand Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in current allocated funds.
