**SUMMARY:** Designates multiple bridges, highways, and interchanges throughout the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation designates multiple bridges, roads, and interchanges throughout the Commonwealth.

Section 59 of the legislation repeals Act 86 of 2021, Act 5 of 2022, and Act 45 of 2020 as they effectuate sections 56, 57, and 58 respectively.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, or interchange costs \$500. Since there are 58 designations, the estimated cost of this legislation is \$29,000. This cost can be absorbed in current allocated funds.
