SUMMARY:

House Bill 1665 amends Act 164 of 1970, which concerns indemnification agreements between architects, engineers, or surveyors and owners, contractors, subcontractors, or suppliers. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1665 adds a new section to Act 164 of 1970. This new section concerns indemnification agreements relating to snow removal or ice control services. It provides that, in a snow removal or ice control services contract between a provider and a receiver, any provision which provides that the receiver be indemnified, held harmless or insured by the provider from damages, claims, losses or expenses arising from bodily injury to persons, damage to property or economic damage caused by or resulting from the receiver's negligence, is void if the provider has been affirmatively directed not to perform the snow removal or ice control by the receiver. A provider of snow removal or ice control services includes agents or employees of the provider.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
