SUMMARY: House Bill 1738, printer's number 2369, establishes an act providing for the review and implementation of executive orders issued by the President of the United States.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would allow the General Assembly to review any executive orders issued by the President of the United States. Upon review, the General Assembly may, by a majority vote in either chamber, recommend that executive orders be further examined by the Joint State Government Commission (JSGC). The JSGC is to determine the impact of the executive order on the Commonwealth and if an exemption from such an order should be sought.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT: The enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. According to the JSGC, any potential costs associated with this bill can be absorbed within their existing budget.
