SUMMARY: Amends the Engineer, Land Surveyor and Geologist Registration Law pertaining to procedures for licensing as a professional engineer. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Act 367 of 1945, otherwise known as the Engineer, Land Surveyor and Geologist Registration Law, to update the qualification requirements for examination.

Under the legislation, an applicant is permitted to take the principles and practice examination for licensure as a professional engineer so long as they hold an engineer-in-training certificate and provide proof of four or more years of experience in engineering work performed under the supervision of a professional engineer, regardless of when the required experience occurred.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
