SUMMARY:

House Bill 1813 amends the Public School Code concerning military child advance enrollment. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1813 amends the Public School Code by adding a section concerning military child advance enrollment. It provides that a school district must adopt a policy or revise an existing policy on enrollment to allow a child whose parent or legal guardian is an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including a reservist, and has received official military orders to transfer into or within Pennsylvania, to enroll in the district prior to establishing residency by providing a copy of the official military orders to the school district and proof of the parent or guardian's intention to move into the district. Proof may include a signed contract to purchase a home, a signed lease agreement or a statement from the parent or legal guardian. Subsequently, any child who establishes residency in this manner must provide to the school district proof of residence no later than ten days after the arrival date specified in the military order.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
