SUMMARY:

House Bill 1929 amends the Crimes Code concerning prohibited offensive weapons. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Under current law a person commits a crime if they repair, sell, or otherwise deal in or possess any items on a list of prohibited offensive weapons in the Crimes Code. That list includes daggers, knives, razors or cutting instruments, the blades of which are exposed in an automatic way by switch, push-button, spring mechanism, or otherwise. House Bill 1929 would remove those types of cutting instruments from the list of prohibited offensive weapons.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
