SUMMARY: Designates a road in Luzerne County as the Honorable George C. Hasay Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of U.S. Route 11, also known as Main Street, from Segment 200, Offset 0000 to the intersection with Oak Street in Shickshinny Borough, Luzerne County, as the Honorable George C. Hasay Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
