**SUMMARY:** Amends the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act (Act 45 of 1999) to allow for the use of alternate refrigerants as allowed by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act (Act 45 of 1999) to allow for the use of a refrigerant prohibited by the Uniform Construction Code (UCC) or related technical standard only if it is permitted by the EPA and the equipment is listed and installed in accordance with the Clean Air Act.

This exemption section will expire once the 2024 model codes developed by the International Code Council are reviewed by the Review and Advisory Council (RAC) and adopted by the Dept. of Labor and Industry.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
