SUMMARY:

House Bill 2143 amends Title 61 (Prisons and Parole) concerning county correctional institutions, further providing for establishment. It would take effect December 31, 2021, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2143 amends Title 61 to require prisons in counties advancing to Second Class-A status on or after October 1, 2021 to be governed by a board of inspectors of county prisons. Any county already subject to a board of inspectors of county prisons is required to continue to be governed by a board of inspectors retroactively to October 1, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
