SUMMARY: House Bill 2214, Printer's Number 3065, amends Title 67 (Public Welfare) to render void certain indemnification clauses in children and youth services contracts. This legislation would be effective in 90 days.

ANALYSIS: HB 2214 adds a new section to Title 67 to provide that any clause in a contract between a county child and youth agency and an entity that provides children and youth services under Title 55, Part V of the Pennsylvania Code that indemnifies the county agency for damages arising from the county agency's own negligence shall be void and unenforceable.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to the Department of Human Services, enactment of this legislation should have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
