**SUMMARY**: House Bill 2287, Printer's Number 2675 as amended by A05635, amends Titles 23 (Domestic Relations) and 51 (Military Affairs) to establish the Uniform Deployed Parents Custody and Visitation Act. This legislation would be effective 30 days following enactment.

**ANALYSIS**: HB 2287 repeals existing sections of Title 51 relating to child custody proceedings during military deployments and replaces them with a new Chapter 46 Uniform Deployed Parents Custody and Visitation. Chapter 46 contains definitions and provisions that apply generally to custody matters of military service members, as well as specific provisions applicable to custody during and following military deployment. The bill amends relevant sections of Title 23 to reference the new Chapter 46 in Title 51.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: Enactment of this legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
