SUMMARY: House Bill 2361, Printer's Number 2775, designates June 12 of each year as Women Veterans Day in Pennsylvania.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Title 38 (Holidays and Observances) by inserting Section 1304 to recognize Women Veterans Day and officially designating June 12 of each year as Women Veterans Day in this Commonwealth. The purpose is to recognize the contributions of women serving in the military prior to and since being officially recognized on June 12, 1948, with the Women's Armed Services Integration Act.

The bill states that "Women Veterans Day is not considered a separate day for only women veterans, but a tribute to a groundbreaking day when women were acknowledged as essential to the war effort and could serve as permanent, regular members of the United States Armed Forces." The Governor shall also issue annually a proclamation encouraging residents of this Commonwealth to observe Women Veterans Day and recognize the contributions of all women veterans and the sacrifices they made.

This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
