SUMMARY: House Bill 2425, Printer's Number 3505, establishes the Communication of Older Adult Abuse Act regarding communication of allegations of abuse to long-term care facility residents. This legislation would be effective 60 days following enactment.

ANALYSIS: HB 2425 requires that an abuse allegation concerning a resident of a long-term care facility that is made to either the Department of Health (DOH) or the Department of Human Services (DHS) must be communicated to the appropriate entity responsible for investigation. The bill requires DOH, DHS, and the Department of Aging (PDA) to have ongoing communication to determine the most effective and efficient manner to share allegations of abuse.

FISCAL IMPACT: Any costs to DHS, DOH, or PDA associated with routing abuse allegations to the proper entity would be minimal and could be accommodated within existing resources.
