**SUMMARY:** Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to allow a permitted vehicle or combination to haul a dozer with an attached blade. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Section 4962 (Conditions of permits and security for damages) of the Vehicle Code allowing for conditions in which a dozer blade may be hauled by a permitted vehicle or combination. A dozer with an attached blade exceeding 12 feet in width, but not wider than 15 feet may move upon a highway if one of the following conditions are met:

- 1.) A traffic protector guiderail is attached to the dozer; or
- 2.) The dozer blade is angled so the total width of the load does not exceed 12 feet.

A dozer blade over 15 feet in width must be removed and hauled separately.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
