SUMMARY: Senate Bill 155, Printer's Number 227, revises the membership terms for appointees of the Military Community Enhancement Commission.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Title 12 (Commerce and Trade), specifically Section 402(e)(1) addressing the membership terms of the Military Community Enhancement Commission as follows:

- The terms for members appointed by the Governor are increased from two to three years and members serve until their respective successors are appointed. Members appointed by the Governor shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
- The term of the Lieutenant Governor is increased from two to four years; and
- Existing terms for other members, including appointments made by the Senate President pro tempore, Senate Minority Leader, House Minority Leader and the Speaker of the House, shall remain two years. Members shall serve until their respective successors are appointed.

This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
