SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 266 appropriates funding for the University of Pittsburgh. It would take effect July 1, 2021, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pittsburgh for the 2021-22 fiscal year. The appropriation for General Support receives \$151,507,000 and Rural Education Outreach receives \$3,346,000. These are both the same amounts appropriated for 2020-21.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$154,853,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- for General Support, \$151,507,000;
- for Rural Education Outreach, \$3,346,000.
