SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 269 appropriates funding for the University of Pennsylvania for veterinary activities and infectious disease research. It would take effect July 1, 2021, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pennsylvania for the 2021-22 fiscal year. The appropriation for Veterinary Activities receives \$31,660,000 and the appropriation for the Center for Infectious Diseases receives \$295,000 for the 2021-22 fiscal year. These appropriations are level funded with the current FY 2020-21 fiscal year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$31,955,000 is provided to the University of Pennsylvania in the following appropriations:

- for Veterinary Activities, \$31,660,000;
- for the Center for Infectious Diseases, \$295,000.
