SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 588 amends the Crimes Code (Title 18) concerning when prosecutions are barred by former prosecutions for different offenses. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 588 amends the Crimes Code to create an exception to the compulsory joinder rule and thereby permit prosecutors to try summary offenses separate from any misdemeanor or felony charges that arise from the same conduct or criminal episode.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
