SUMMARY: Senate Bill 729, Printer's Number 831, amends the Nurse Aide Resident Abuse Prevention Training Act to permit virtual instruction for certified nurse aide training programs. This legislation is effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: SB 729 permits curriculum content for the theory and laboratory requirements of a State-approved nurse aide training program to be delivered in class, in person, online, via virtual reality, via other digital delivery methods, or in a blended format. The bill requires the Department of Education to submit an annual report to the General Assembly regarding implementation of this section.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
