SUMMARY: Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to change the temporary regulation expiration date regarding side stop signal arm enforcement systems. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes a change to the expiration date of the temporary regulations within Section 3345.1 (Enforcement of failure to stop for school bus with flashing red lights), regarding department approval, to extend PennDOT's deadline to approve and promulgate regulations from three to five years.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
