**SUMMARY**: Senate Bill 904, Printer's Number 1140, amends the Judicial Code to provide that a probation officer may utilize virtual technology to meet with an offender. This legislation would be effective in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS**: SB 904 amends the Judicial Code to provide that notwithstanding Section 6.1(h)(5) of the Commission on Crime and Delinquency Law, a probation office may utilize technology portals in lieu of requiring an offender who has been released on probation to appear in person at a meeting.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
