SUMMARY: Senate Bill 905, printer's number 1141, amends the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency Law, further providing for the County Adult Probation and Parole Advisory Committee.

ANALYSIS: This legislation requires the County Adult Probation and Parole Advisory Committee, when making recommendations and adopting standards for probation and parole personnel, to consider circumstances under which an offender's schedule should be weighed when making scheduling decisions. Examples of considerations include an offender's work schedule or essential medical care.

FISCAL IMPACT: The enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
