SUMMARY: Senate Bill 1019, printer's number 1524, amends the Administrative Code further providing for COVID-19 regulatory flexibility authority.

ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 1019 extends most of the regulatory suspensions contained in Act 73 of 2021 until June 30, 2022. Current regulatory suspensions related to the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs, the Office of Administration, and the Department of Revenue would not be extended. Regulations related to Section 449 of the Workers' Compensation Act and 34 Pa. Code § 101.110 would also not be extended.

The legislation also states that no later than August 31, 2022, each authority which initially authorized a suspension which was extended shall issue an updated report, which shall be published online and be provided to each member of the General Assembly.

This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT: This bill has no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The final reporting provisions in the legislation can be accomplished within current funding levels.
