SUMMARY: Amends the Child Labor Act to allow minors that are seventeen years old to perform firefighting training modules with live burns if they have the proper approval and supervision. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends section 7(a)(5) of Act 151 of 2012, known as the Child Labor Act, to allow minors to enter a burning structure to perform volunteer firefighter training with live burns if the following conditions are met:

- The minor performing the training with live burns must be at least 17 years old.
- The minor has permission from a fire chief and a parent or guardian.
- The minor is under the supervision of a credentialed PA State Fire Academy instructor.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or political subdivision funds.
