SUMMARY: Allows tow trucks to be equipped with one or more flashing or revolving blue lights in addition to flashing or revolving yellow and white lights. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends section 4572.1 (relating to flashing or revolving lights on tow trucks) of Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to allow a tow truck to be equipped with one or more flashing or revolving yellow lights and one or more revolving or flashing blue lights. The blue lights may only be equipped in the rear of the tow truck. A tow truck may only operate with blue lights while the vehicle is stationary on the side of the road or highway while responding to a disabled vehicle. The tow truck is prohibited from operating blue lights at any time while the tow truck is in motion.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
