SUMMARY: Raises the fee for the USA Semiquincentennial (250th) plate from \$50 to \$52, and directs that \$25 of that fee be directed to the Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends section 1369.4 (related to USA semiquincentennial registration plates) of Title 75 (Vehicles) to increase the fee for a UA Semiquincentennial plate from \$50 to \$52.

The legislation also requires that \$25 of the \$52 fee must be deposited into the newly established Semiquincentennial Restricted Account for use by the Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial for activities related to the semiquincentennial.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, the Semiquincentennial license plate became available for issuance on November 1, 2021. There have been 200 of these license plates issued during the past six months. Assuming the same level of plate sales, this would result in 400 of these plates being sold annually. If that is the case, those sales would generate \$20,800 annually. Of that amount, \$10,800 would be deposited into the Motor License Fund, and \$10,000 would be deposited into the newly established Semi quincentennial Restricted Account in the State Treasury.
