SUMMARY: Senate Bill 1284 authorizes the appropriation of moneys contained within the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund restricted receipt account for Agricultural Research and Extension Services. It would take effect July 1, 2022, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS: This legislation authorizes the appropriation of moneys contained within the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund restricted receipt account for Agricultural Research and Extension Services. Funds provided for in this account are appropriated as part of the General Appropriation Act as the Transfer to the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022, or immediately, whichever is later.

FISCAL IMPACT: The cost of this legislation is dependent upon the amount appropriated in the General Appropriation Act for the Transfer to the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund for Fiscal Year 2022-23. It should be noted that the appropriation amount for the Transfer to the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund is \$54,960,000 in the current FY 2021-22 budget.
