SUMMARY: SB 251 PN 214 requires the Department of General Services to create a program for purchase of State Police pursuit vehicles by local or regional police departments. This legislation would take effect in sixty (60) days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Administrative Code (Act 175 of 1929), to require the Department of General Services (DGS) to create a program designed to allow a local or regional police department to purchase select used pursuit vehicles at a fixed price no later than twenty days prior to the next scheduled sale date. Furthermore, DGS would be required to promulgate rules and regulations necessary for the administration of the program.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to the Department of General Services, it would cost \$3,000 to design and distribute the applicable design form. In addition, the Department would be able to promulgate rules and regulations and administer the program with the current available complement and no additional resources would be required.
