SUMMARY:

House Bill 404 Printer's Number 1301 amends Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, Chapter 75 Professional and Occupational licenses to allow those persons entering military service to retain their license when inducted or drafted into military service.

ANALYSIS:

HB404 amends Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, Section 7502 Retention of licenses and certifications of persons entering military service by adding to the listed agencies in this Section the Department of Health and the Department of Agriculture.

Individuals holding licenses or certifications from any of the listed Commonwealth agencies, including those added, will be able to retain their license or certification when inducted or drafted into military or naval service during a time of war or preparation for nation defense during a national emergency.

This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

This legislation has no fiscal impact.
