SUMMARY:

Amends the Act of April 9, 1929, known as the Administrative Code, to allow the Department of Health to partner with health care providers to educate women on perimenopause and menopause.

ANALYSIS:

HB807 amends the Administrative Code to allow the Department of Health to partner with health care providers, community-based health centers, and hospitals to educate women on the systems, processes and other issue regarding perimenopause and menopause. This includes the creation of informational materials what can be distributed or accessed by women who the health care provider has determined are experiencing or are expected to soon experience perimenopause and menopause.

Informational materials include:

- Symptoms and treatments,
- Circumstances when a women should consult a health care provider,
- Recommendations on how to discuss these conditions with family and friends, and
- Other information as deemed necessary.

This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact. The Department of Health may have nominal costs to develop and distribute the required informational materials. However, the current appropriations for the department are sufficient to cover this nominal cost increase.
