SUMMARY: HB 1044 PN 1787 makes changes to the littering acknowledgment printed on vehicle registration cards and applications for learner's permit or driver's licenses. This legislation would take effect in one year.

ANALYSIS: Legislation amends Title 75 (Vehicles) Section 1317 and 1520 (both relating to acknowledgment of littering provisions), to change the current language required to be printed on vehicle registration card, learner's permit, or driver's license.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, the enactment of this legislation would have a fiscal impact of \$35,000 to Commonwealth funds. Specifically, verbiage changes, within the legislation, will impact all PennDOT registration products, and that will require system changes to the Commonwealth Automated Registration and Titling System as well as vendors' systems. Total costs are estimated to be \$36,400 (\$35,000 for PennDOT systems changes and \$1,400 for vendor systems). Commonwealth costs would be realized within the Motor License Fund.
