SUMMARY:

Requires that courts solicit and consider the opinions of potential kinship care resources in child custody proceedings.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1058 Printer's Number 1471 amends Title 41 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) Section 6336.1(a) to require the court to direct the county agency or juvenile probation department to provide an individual seeking to become a kinship care resource with notice of the hearing. The bill also provides the individual seeking to become a kinship care resource with the right to be heard pertaining to their qualifications as a kinship care provider.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
