SUMMARY:

House Bill 1094 amends the Public School Code to require school districts to develop policies for the advanced enrollment of children whose parent or legal guardian is an active duty service member.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1094 amends Article XIII – Pupils and Attendance – of the Public School Code to allow a parent or legal guardian who is an active duty service member to enroll their child in a school district prior to establishing residency. The student's parent or guardian must provide the school district with a copy of their official military orders to transfer into or within the commonwealth as well as proof of their intention to move into the school district. Proof of residence is required no later than 45 days after the arrival date specified in the military orders.

House Bill 1094 takes effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1094 would have no fiscal impact on commonwealth funds.

Enactment of this legislation will require school districts to update or create a policy at little or no cost.
