#### SUMMARY:

HB 1246 PN 1415 changes the minimum operating temperature for crematories. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

#### ANALYSIS:

The bill creates the Crematory Regulations Act to establish crematory operation requirements. In addition, the bill establishes minimum operating temperature for crematories, built after April 17, 1989, at 1,600 degrees Fahrenheit and applies to crematories that hold/apply for general plan approval or a general permit through the Department of Environmental Protection.

Furthermore, crematory incinerators are required to utilize an interlock system.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on commonwealth funds. The commonwealth currently has minimum operating temperature requirements, so there would be no cost to adjust these operating requirements to a different temperature.
