SUMMARY: HB 1338 PN 1614 provides that local ordinances, in cities regarding ATVs and dirt bikes, are not preempted by state law. This legislation would take effect in sixty (60) days.

ANALYSIS: Legislation amends Title 75 (Vehicles) Section 1338 (related to off-road vehicles in urban municipalities). Specifically, to provide that state law shall not supersede or preempt a local ordinance adopted by an urban municipality, that prohibits, permits, or regulates the operation of ATVs or dirt bikes inside the boundaries of the urban community.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, the enactment of this legislation would not have an impact on Commonwealth funds.
