#### SUMMARY:

Requires that uniformed police officers in a county, city, or municipality visibly display an identifying badge, tag, or label at all times.

#### ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1399 amends Title 53 to add Section 2173, which requires uniformed police officers in a county, city, or municipality to visibly display a badge, tag, or label clearly identifying the officer at all times. This requirement does not apply to a police officer or other person empowered to make arrests in a county, city, or municipality who is not in uniform.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
