SUMMARY: HB 1409 PN 1577 extends the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission's ability to establish license and permit fees through 2035 and amends Title 30 (Fish). This legislation would take effect in sixty (60) days.

ANALYSIS: The legislation amends Title 30 (Fish) to allow the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission the power to set license and permit fees until July 15, 2035, which currently expires in July of 2025.

Additionally, Section 2715 of Title 30 is amended to change various license and permit fees from a set dollar amount to an amount determined by the Commission contained within the Pennsylvania Code Title 58 (Recreation), Section 63.57 (Relating to License, Permit, and Issuing Agent Fees)

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no negative impact on Commonwealth funds, as this bill extends the existing powers of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission.
