SUMMARY:

House Bill 1730 amends Act 320 of 1937 (Pennsylvania Election Code) to require reporting of an independent expenditure of any amount by any 501(c) organization.

ANALYSIS:

This bill requires any organization under 26 U.S.C. § 501(c) (relating to exemption from tax on corporations, certain trusts, etc.) who makes expenditures in any amount advocating for or against a candidate or question appearing on the ballot to be reported to the Secretary of the Commonwealth. Furthermore, an independent expenditure of any amount after the final pre-election report would be required to be reported.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation would have no impact on commonwealth funds.
