SUMMARY:

House Bill 1477 amends the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code to allow for electronic transmittal of certain documents.

ANALYSIS:

This bill clarifies that municipalities shall be allowed to submit proposed comprehensive plans, amendments, or proposed land use ordinances or amendments for review, comments, or recommendations electronically. This transmittal may include either an electronic document or a link to a publicly accessible document online. The submitting municipality shall transmit documents to reasonably appropriate contacts and maintain a written or electronic record of every transmittal.

This act would take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
