SUMMARY: HB 1543 PN 1795 repeals obsolete agriculture transportation laws relating to bridge crossings with certain livestock. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation repeals obsolete provisions of Act 169 of 1836 (referred to as General Road Law) and Act 70 of 1864 (supplement to an act relating to roads, highways, and bridges). The following are repealed:

- Act 169 of 1836
 - Section 70 – Crossing a bridge with horse faster than a walk
 - Section 71 – Driving cattle faster than a walk
 - Section 72 – Carrying open fire over a bridge
- Act 70 of 1864
 - A supplement that extends Act 169 of 1836 to include iron bridges

FISCAL IMPACT: The enactment of this legislation would have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The bill simply repeals provisions of Act 169 of 1836 and Act 70 of 1864, which are obsolete.
